IMPORTANT COVID-19/CHINA VIRUS PUBLIC HEALTH ALERT UPDATE:

Gideon Lodge is continuing to remain fluid in our responses to the current health alerts. We continue to get some direction from Grand Lodge around Stated Meetings and Degrees. The situation remains fluid – keep checking with other brothers and our online calendar of events.



Fraternal Greetings Brethren:

I hope this message finds you well. It's been a crazy few months with this pandemic, but I think we are at the end of the tunnel.

I'd like to start by asking for payers for some of our brothers and families, Bro. George Fales wife is very ill, Bro. Lavelle has been in and out of the hospital, but I've spoken to him and he sounds good. Also, RW Bro. Weyler is doing great and pretty much back into his busy schedule. If you know of any brothers needing assistance or just a call let one of my officers or myself know, and we'll be right there.

Next, I would like to apologize to all brothers who did not receive their May Trestle Board. They were sent out the 3rd week on May, so all of you should have received it by the time you get this month's Trestle Board. We emailed the electronic copy out, but due to some issues around the current health situation, we were unable to get them out on time.

Our last regular Stated Meeting before we go Dark for the summer is coming up on June 2nd. I've decided (with the ok of the DDGM) to have our stated meeting. In addition, we will be doing a FC degree for Bro. Steinel. I've spoken to our Grand Lecturer and he will be in attendance to perform our inspection.

If you are quarantined, shut in or can't get out and need some assistance, please reach out to one of the line officers or any brother.


